Since completing his chiropractic studies at Macquarie, he continued his dedication to spinal rehabilitation, certifying as an Advanced Fellow of Chiropractic BioPhysics. Dr. McAviney is one of the few chiropractors to achieve a Masters degree in Pain Medicine under Professor Nikolai Bogduk. His sole focus is now the treatment of scoliosis in adults and in children. Dr. McAviney completed advanced SpineCor training at St. Justine Children's Hospital in Canada. Dr. McAviney has instructed Medical doctors, Chiropractors, Physical Therapists, Orthotists, Nurses and hospital staff in the application and implementation of the SpineCor dynamic scoliosis brace and rehabilitation programs.



Dr. Brent Gordon has a special research interest in the applied neurosciences. He has done extensive training in Neurology by the American Chiropractic Neurology Board and has lectured in Neurology and Pre-clinical studies at Macquarie University over 12 years. Dr. Gordon has published numerous papers in peer-reviewed journals and has received many awards including for Radiology, Academic Excellence, human cadaver dissection and even has the title Prosector. Dr. Gordon will stimulate the audience with neurological function and scoliosis.

Dr. Inger Villadsen's studies were commenced at Odense University then completed at the Anglo European College of Chiropractic. Her main clinical interests are the rehabilitation of chronic conditions and the implementation of preventative measures against re-occurrence for patients presenting with back pain. Dr. Villadsen holds a Master's degree in Clinical Epidemiology and is one of only two instructors certified by Prague's Motol University in Czech Republic to teach, Dynamic Neuromusculoskeletal Stabilisation (DNS) in Australasia and is currently undertaking a second Masters in NMS Rehabilitation at Murdoch University. Dr. Villadsen will guide the seminar in the role of Dynamic Neuromusculoskeletal Stabilisation in spinal stability and its benefits for scoliosis. She will demonstrate practical exercises for the benefit of these conditions.
